As per the clause 2.9 Sr. – III mentioned in the Tender document and as per the provisions of the Ministry of Finance Office Memorandum dated 14-07-2009, Successful Bidder shall enter into Agreement / MoU within a period of 90 days from the date of signing of Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) with the agency having technological expertise & successful experience of the Floating Solar Power Project or Solar Project on Water body of at least 10% of the Project Capacity mentioned in this tender document including O & M for at least 2 (two) years.
